

Binocular Sky Reviews Policy

I am occasionally asked by suppliers of binoculars to review their products. I am willing to do this under the following conditions:

- The product must be suitable for astronomy.
- It must not be a product that I have previously reviewed or am due to review in my capacity as binocular reviewer for *BBC Sky at Night* magazine, *The Binocular Shop*, or other suppliers with whom I have a prior review agreement.
- The cost of delivery and collection of product is borne by the supplier.
- In case of theft, damage or loss, the product is covered by the supplier's insurance.
- I must be able to have the product for at least 60 days (two full lunar months) to test.
- We must agree which binocular(s) I will review and the review period before you dispatch the product.
- The review will be impartial and will be amended **only** in the event of objective factual error.
- If I wish, I may publish the review, in my standard review format, on my [website](#), with a [Creative Commons CC-BY-SA license](#).
- If you require a review in any other format or with any other license, this should be agreed beforehand. Please [contact me](#) to discuss this.
